#1	Video 1	Right-click on My Computer and click <b>Manage.</b> The Computer Management window will open.
#2	Video 1	In the Left window pane click <b>Disk Management</b> . In the lower portion of the right hand side, right-click on <b>Disk 0</b> <b>Basic</b> and Click <b>Upgrade to Dynamic Disk</b>
#3	Video 1	The Upgrade to Dynamic Disk window will appear. Be sure there is a check mark in the box next to Disk 0 and click <b>OK</b> . The next window is Disk to Upgrade, check to be sure the information is correct and click <b>Upgrade</b> .
#4	Video 1	A window will appear called Disk Management. It will ask "Are you sure you want to upgrade?" click <b>Yes</b> . One last warning will appear about dismounting the file system. Click <b>Yes</b> . Click <b>OK</b> to reboot this will complete the upgrade process.

#5	Video 2	Once the computer reboots, log back on. A <b>System Settings</b> <b>Change</b> window will appear, stating Windows 2000 has installed new devices and will need to restart. Click <b>Yes</b> .

#7	Video 2	Notice where it says Disk 0, it now says <b>Dynamic</b> instead of Basic. The conversion is complete.
