#1	video 1	Power on the Computer, when the black Starting Windows bar appears at the bottom of the screen, press <b>F8</b> .
#2	video 1	The Windows 2000 Advanced Options Menu will have a list of options to choose from. Use the up and down arrows to navigate <b>Safe Mode</b> and press <b>Enter</b> . Windows will now startup in Safe Mode.

#3	video 2	When Windows boots up a warning will appear. Read the warning and click <b>OK</b> .
#4	video 2	Click <b>Start</b> , <b>Control Panel</b> and double-click the <b>System</b> icon. After the <b>System Properties</b> window opens click the <b>Hardware</b> tab and then click the <b>Device Manger</b> button in the middle of the window.
#5	video 2	Next to <b>Network adapters</b> click the (+) to expand the submenu. Find the adapter you want to want to view and <b>right-click</b> the adapter and left-click <b>Properties</b> .
#6	video 2	Notice there are no drivers installed for the networking device, when booting into Safe Mode.
