#1	Video 1	Log into the computer with the assigned <b>username</b> and
		<b>password</b> . Click the <b>OK</b> button. This will start the
		Windows desktop environment.

		Computer icon and then <b>double-click</b> it.
#3	Video 3	Select the new view option for the folders. Move the
