#1	video 1	Click <b>Start &gt; Programs &gt; MS-DOS Prompt.</b> This will open the Command line in a separate window.
#2	video 1	At the prompt type <b>format a:</b> /s
#3	video 1	Now the computer will ask for a diskette to be inserted in the A: drive, put one in if necessary. Then push <b>Enter</b> when finished.
#4	video 1	The computer will format the diskette and transfer the system files to the diskette. When the transfer is complete the Volume Label prompt will appear, to choose the default just press <b>Enter</b> .
#5	video 1	Then the option to format another diskette will appear, type (n) for no or (y) for yes. For now type $(n)$ .
#6	video 1	Next, by typing <b>'exit'</b> , this will close the command window, and making a DOS boot disk is complete.
