Step 1	Description
#1 video 1	Place the Windows 2000 Professional CD in the CD-ROM and restart the computer. After the computer reboots the Windows 2000 Setup will begin.
#2 video 1	Windows 2000 Setup will load files and drivers that Windows 2000 needs to start.
Step 2	Description
#5 video 2	Next the Setup program will give the option to setup Windows 2000 now, repair Windows 2000, or quit without installing Windows 2000. Press <b>Enter</b> to continue with the installation.
#6 video 2	The next option is to erase all the data currently on the hard disk or quit the Setup. Press C to continue.
#7 video 2	Now press <b>F8</b> to agree to Microsoft's Licensing Agreement. Windows Setup will give the option to partition the unpartitioned space or delete a previously partitioned space on the hard disk. After selecting the space to install Windows 2000 press <b>Enter</b> .
#8 video 2	The partition can be formatted using the NTFS or FAT file system. Choose one and press <b>Enter</b> . Windows Setup will now format and examine the C: drive, then it will start to copy to the Windows 2000 installation folders. Once this is complete Windows will reboot.
Step 3	Description
#9 video 3	Once Windows reboots the Windows 2000 Setup Wizard will start. Click <b>Next</b> to begin. Setup will first detect the devices installed on the computer. Then the regions and languages can be customized. When completed click <b>Next</b> . Next type your Name and Organization and click <b>Next</b> .
#10 video 3	Enter the correct Product Key then click <b>Next</b> . The following screen, enter the <b>Computer Name</b> and enter an <b>Administrator password</b> to have full access to the computer. When complete click <b>Next</b> .
#11 video 3	Now select the correct <b>Date</b> and <b>Time</b> , click <b>Next</b> . Setup will then detect the network setting and ask to choose <b>Typical</b> or <b>Custom</b> settings, and then click <b>Next</b>

#12 video 3	The question will be asked 'Do you want this computer to be a member of a domain?' choose the appropriate setting and click <b>Next</b> to continue. Setup will then install the Windows 2000 components and perform final takes like install Start menu items, register components, save settings, and remove temporary files. Now click <b>Finish</b> and that will complete the Network Identification Wizard. Windows 2000 will continue to boot and the screen 'Getting Started with Windows 2000' will appear.
