

Video Title: Installing Windows 2000 Professional

Step 1	Description
#1 video 1	Place the Windows 2000 Professional CD in the CD-ROM and restart the computer. After the computer reboots the Windows 2000 Setup will begin.
#2 video 1	Windows 2000 Setup will load files and drivers that Windows 2000 needs to start.
Step 2	Description
#5 video 2	Next the Setup program will give the option to setup Windows 2000 now, repair Windows 2000, or quit without installing Windows 2000. Press Enter to continue with the installation.
#6 video 2	The next option is to erase all the data currently on the hard disk or quit the Setup. Press C to continue.
#7 video 2	Now press F8 to agree to Microsoft's Licensing Agreement. Windows Setup will give the option to partition the unpartitioned space or delete a previously partitioned space on the hard disk. After selecting the space to install Windows 2000 press Enter .
#8 video 2	The partition can be formatted using the NTFS or FAT file system. Choose one and press Enter . Windows Setup will now format and examine the C: drive, then it will start to copy to the Windows 2000 installation folders. Once this is complete Windows will reboot.
Step 3	Description
#9 video 3	Once Windows reboots the Windows 2000 Setup Wizard will start. Click Next to begin. Setup will first detect the devices installed on the computer. Then the regions and languages can be customized. When completed click Next . Next type your Name and Organization and click Next .
#10 video 3	Enter the correct Product Key then click Next . The following screen, enter the Computer Name and enter an Administrator password to have full access to the computer. When complete click Next .
#11 video 3	Now select the correct Date and Time , click Next . Setup will then detect the network setting and ask to choose Typical or Custom settings, and then click Next

#12 video 3	The question will be asked 'Do you want this computer to be a member of a domain?' choose the appropriate setting and click Next to continue. Setup will then install the Windows 2000 components and perform final tasks like install Start menu items, register components, save settings, and remove temporary files. Then click Finish to reboot the computer
Step 4	Description
#13 video 4	Once the computer is rebooted there is the option to enter a password for Microsoft Networking. For now just click OK .
#14 video 4	Once Windows 2000 reboots the Network Identification Wizard will appear. Click Next to start. The Network Identification Wizard will ask 'Who can log on to this computer?' choose the correct option and click Next . Now click Finish and that will complete the Network Identification Wizard. Windows 2000 will continue to boot and the screen 'Getting Started with Windows 2000' will appear. The installation is complete.
