

Video title: Remote Desktop Connection

Step 1	Description
#1 Video 1	Setting up the first computer. Start by clicking Start, Control Panel, and System . A System Properties Box will open, click the Remote tab.
#2 Video 1	Under the Remote tab in the Remote Desktop area place a check in the box “Allow users to connect remotely to this computer”
#3 Video 1	This will bring up the Remote Sessions box read the contents and click OK . Next click Select Remote Users , the Remote Desktop Users box will appear. Click Add , in the Select Users box under “Enter the object names to select”, enter the name of the user allowed access to this computer. Click OK .
#4 Video 1	Now the User entered can be seen in the white box, click OK . Click Apply then OK in the System Properties box
#6 Video 1	Next click Start, Run . Enter cmd in the Run box, click OK . When the command line appears enter ipconfig/all . Note the Host Name and IP Address . Now the first computer is setup next the second computer will be setup
Step 2	
#7 Video 2	Setting up the second computer. Start by clicking Start, All Programs, Accessories, Communications, Remote Desktop Connection . When the Remote Desktop Connection is open type the IP Address of the first computer in the white box.
#8 Video 2	Next click Options under the General tab where it says User name: type the name of the user that used in the first part, in this case it is garrett. Click Connect . This will connect the remote computer to the host computer giving the user access to the files on the computer.
